This year continues to be an amazing time of ministry for Alabaster Project. In addition to our normal dental, eye care services and discipleship formation programs that has been going on for the past 27 years, we have started weekly outreaches in villages where the gospel has never been shared. This is affording opportunity for many first time hearers of the Gospel (Rom. 15:20). Previously it was difficult to share the Gospel with some of the older members of the Dagomba tribe, but now God has moved by His Spirit to open their eyes and hearts to hear and believe that Jesus is indeed the Christ. They are coming to augment our manpower as we serve the marginalized with health and the gospel. Their addition is very much needed to help us enhance our capacities. Thanks be to God for helping provide this decent and secure accommodations for all of us ministering in this remote part of the continent. The completion of this mission house will afford us the capacity to host teams that previously were unable to come.

SOUTH AMERICAN OUTREACH

Currently, we are in South America helping to disciple and mobilize believers who are called into the Lord's vineyard for the end time harvest. This gathering focused on the Brazilian state of Bahia, the least reached state in Brazil. In fact, it is a frontier so far as the gospel is concern. Only 23.3% of the population are Evangelicals, with the highest percentage of Afro-Brazilian religions in the whole country. The Lord has planned a great harvest, and many of the participants have heard him calling them to mission service, among their countrymen in Bahia. Most places we were invited
